Comox Valley Hospice Society Notes to the Compiled Financial Information

For the year ended March 31, 2022

1. Basis of accounting

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the financial information of Comox Valley Hospice Society as at March 31, 2022 is on the historical cost basis, reflecting cash transactions with the addition of:

- accounts receivable less an allowance for doubtful accounts
- prepaid expenses
- property and equipment amortized over their useful lives
- accounts payable and accrued liabilities
- deferred grants and contributions

2. Purpose of the Society

The purpose of the Comox Valley Hospice Society ("the Society") is to ease the journey of dying and grieving for people in the Comox Valley. We provide psycho social and emotional support and anticipatory grief support to those who have been diagnosed as palliative through their end of life process and anticipatory grief and bereavement support to their families and loved ones. The Society was incorporated in 1983 under the BC Society Act and is a registered charity, and as such is exempt from income tax under Section 149 (1)(f) of the Income Tax Act.

3. Other deferred contributions

Other deferred contributions consists of funds received for expenses incurred after year-end.

4. Internally restricted net assets

The Society has internally restricted net assets of \$40,000 in the operating fund (2021 - \$10,000) as a contingency for emergency use only.

6. Contributed services

Volunteers contribute a significant number of hours per year to assist the Society in carrying out its service delivery activities. In the calendar 2021 year volunteers contributed 4,389 (2020 - 5,320) hours at an estimated value of \$118,503 (2020 - \$106,400). This has not been recorded in the financial statements.
